

Turn right onto the All American Freeway, which turns into Owen drive. Go 2.9 miles and turn Right onto Gillespie/I-95 BUS S/US-301 S. After .5 mile turn Left onto E Mountain Dr. in .4 mile turn right onto Companion Ct. The building is on the left at the end of the gravel road.

From Raleigh, NC

FROM I-95N/S: Take Exit # 46B Hwy. 87N. Go 1.5 miles to exit #100 Owen Dr. Turn left onto Owen Dr. and go approx. 1 mile up to the top of the hill and in the curve, turn left onto E. Mountain Dr. Continue 100 yds. until you see the sign for the Woodmen Life on the left. Our road (Companion Ct.) is IMMEDIATELY after the Woodmen Life. Turn left onto the gravel road. Our building is on the left about 1/10 mile from the main road.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. A Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3 for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the dog) and a \$.50 AKC recording fee first entry of each dog; \$25 for each additional entry of the same dog in the same trial. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall he accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Postdated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Entry Limits: Entries limited to 8 hours judging per day for the obedience trials. A wait list will be established.

Bitches that come in season after the closing date of entries may receive a refund, less \$5.00, if certification from a Veterinarian is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the Obedience Trial.

Errors on Entry Forms. Owners are responsible for errors in filling out Entry Forms. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of such errors or due to cancellation of entries after the closing date. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Dogs not entered in the trial will NOT be allowed in the building. Dogs cannot be left in the building overnight. Limited indoor space for crating.

By providing an email address on the entry form, you agree to electronic correspondence for confirmation letter and judging program. If you would like your confirmation letter and judging program sent via US Postal Service, you may either not provide your email address on your entry or you may specifically request snail mail.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have proof of appropriate vaccinations.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Move Up of Dogs in Obedience Classes (Ch. 1 Section 16 of Obedience Regulations). The request for a move up must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move ups may be approved provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

Judges Will Not Wait For Any Dog Holding Up A Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

AKC rules apply for class size limits, 8 hours of judging per day for obedience trials.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside or within 100 feet of any building in which this dog show is conducted.

No Unauthorized Persons will be allowed in the building before 7am Saturday and Sunday.
